Community Inclusion

Community Inclusion advocates for the provision of accommodations, services, treatment, and technology necessary to support the choices of people with disabilities to safely and meaningfully participate as equal citizens in any social, economic, or political aspect of community life.

Community Inclusion activities must meet all 4 criteria:

- 1) Individualized based on the person's interest;
- 2) Integrated with other individuals without disabilities;
- 3) Activities that are typically experienced by the general public of a similar age in the local community, accessible by public transit or a reasonable commute from their home.
- 4) Ability to contribute and develop relationships with community members who are not paid staff.
